RAFFLE TICKET TERMS & CONDITIONS

Board Adopted Revision August 11, 2015

1. PARTICIPATION:

- a. Entrants must be at least 18 years old to enter or win.
- b. The winner need not be present to win.
- c. Principals of donating companies and ASA Board of Directors and their immediate families are not eligible to participate or win.
- d. Proceeds benefit the ASA general fund
- e. Limited to one prize per ticket.

2. DRAWING THE TICKETS:

- a. The raffle drawing will be held at the Sand Sport Super Show (“SSSS”) in Costa Mesa, CA on Sunday afternoon of the SSSS.
- b. If anything prevents the drawing at this time and place, the Board of Directors will meet (in person or on a conference call) as soon as possible and decide on the best alternative. The new drawing location will be open to the public. The Board will advertise the new time and place on the ASA website and in social media and will allow at least five days after notifications are posted to hold the new raffle drawing.
- c. In the event that multiple raffle prizes are to be awarded, the first ticket drawn will be for the prize with the highest overall value. If there is a second raffle prize, it will be for the second highest value prize. If there are additional prizes, the process will continue. The ASA will be the final decision on the value of the prizes.
- d. The raffle winners will not have the choice of which raffle prize they wish to claim. Raffle prizes will be awarded in the order outlined above.
- e. Winners wishing to exchange raffle prizes may request such an exchange only after they have taken possession of their awarded prizes. ASA will try to accommodate such requests, but cannot guarantee that it will be able to do so.

3. ADDITIONAL TICKETS TO BE DRAWN:

- a. After all tickets for all raffle prizes been drawn and announced, two additional tickets will be drawn for each raffle prize. Each ticket will be marked as to which prize it is for and the number of the sequence. The Secretary of the ASA or his/her designee will record the names drawn, which prize it was for, and the sequence of the drawing. The secretary or his/her designee will keep this information secure until all prizes have been awarded. This information will not be announced or revealed to raffle participants or anyone else unless the raffle prize winner does not claim his/her prize after a period of fourteen (14) calendar days following the drawing, per the provisions of paragraph 4.d below.

4. NOTIFYING THE WINNERS:

- a. Upon drawing each ticket, the name of the winner will be announced. If no winner is present at the drawing to claim his/her prize, the phone number on the ticket will be called from the stage to notify the prize winner. If there is no response from either the stage or the phone call, the winner will be notified by the e-mail address (if so provided) on the raffle ticket. A notification letter will also be sent to the address on the ticket (if so provided).
- b. Similarly, if there is a second raffle prize, a second raffle ticket will be drawn and the winner announced and if necessary, called. This procedure will be followed for each prize in descending value order.

- c. Only after all the winning tickets have been drawn will the additional tickets be drawn, per the process outlined in paragraph 3 above.
- d. In the event that the raffle ticket winner has not responded within fourteen (14) days, he or she will be deemed to have forever forfeited and otherwise irrevocably waived his or her right to claim the raffle prize. Under such circumstances, the Secretary of the ASA or his/her designee will then notify the next raffle ticket drawn for that particular raffle prize. If necessary, the process will continue after another fourteen (14) days to the third ticket drawn.

5. TRANSFER AND TAKING POSSESSION OF RAFFLE VEHICLE:

- a. No raffle winner may take possession of a raffle prize until such time as all ownership, registration, and transfer documents have been completed and signed. Each raffle prize winner will be responsible to pick up and transport the raffle prize from the location where it is stored and will cooperate in the preparation and execution of all necessary transfer documents. The ASA makes no representations or warranties about where the raffle prize will be physically located at the time final delivery takes place to the winner. The raffle prize winner will be responsible for all transfer, registration, and ownership fees, taxes, and costs.
- b. As required by IRS rules and regulations, at the appropriate time, the ASA will issue a 1099 form stating the estimated value of the vehicle. This value will be determined prior to the raffle drawing, in conjunction with the builder of the raffle vehicle and based on the value of a similar vehicle that is one year old (the time the ASA has had the vehicle as a raffle prize). The raffle winners will be informed of the form 1099 value prior to accepting the raffle prize.
- c. Title transfer must be complete before the winner takes possession and final delivery.

6. IF A RAFFLE VEHICLE IS NOT READY FOR FINAL DELIVERY:

- a. If for any reason the raffle prize(s) is not ready to be awarded or presented to the winner within a reasonable time after the drawing, the Board will meet as soon as possible in person or via telephone conference to resolve whatever has caused the issue. In the event of a major issue, the ASA will work with its insurance company, vendors, and others as appropriate to replace the raffle prize or correct the cause of the situation. The ASA will do everything in its power to resolve the issue as quickly as possible; however, the ASA will only guarantee to replace or repair the prize in a 'near new' condition and will not assume any costs related to the delay in delivering the raffle prize.

7. RAFFLE RULES AND DISCLAIMERS as noted on the ticket

- a. MUST BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE TO ENTER AND WIN
- b. Drawing held on Sunday, September 17, 2017.
- c. Winner need not be present to win.
- d. Principals of the donating companies and ASA Board of Directors and their families not eligible to win.
- e. Proceeds benefit ASA general fund.
- f. Winner responsible for all taxes and fees.
- g. Purchase of this ticket subject to all terms and conditions of the raffle.
- h. Winner will be required to sign a Liability Release as a condition to accepting the raffle prize. A copy of the Release is available for public review.
- i. Title transfer must be complete before the winner takes possession.
- j. Limited to one prize per ticket.
